Re: California Proposition 65

California's Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, Health and Safety Code Section 25249.5 et seq., is commonly known as "Proposition 65." It requires that anyone who, in the course of doing business in California, knowingly or intentionally exposes an individual to a chemical known to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity, give clear and reasonable warning of the presence of such chemicals.
